Ministry Report | June 2014



Dr. Kim Maas ministered in several states within the U.S. this first half of 2014 at women's conferences, prophetic conferences including The Voice of the Prophets, a Supernatural School of Ministry, a regional leaders and pastors gathering, church services, and a private Christian school graduation. Children of all ages, leaders at every level, and both men and women have been a part of these ministry times.

It has been a very fruitful time. God has moved with intention and intensity through prophetic words, inner and physical healing, prophetic preaching, salvation, signs and wonders, corporate and personal ministry, commissioning, impartations, activations, Spirit-baptisms, and prophetic intercession.

Many have said the time of ministry was "life changing." One woman with a US government position had experienced several deaths of those related to her in the past two years. She said she had not been able to come out of her grief and it was affecting her work. She loved Jesus but could not get breakthrough. In a personal ministry time the Holy Spirit came upon her and she experienced Holy Laughter for the first time. The intense grief was broken.

During a worship session in Missouri, there was fire waiting to be released. From the platform Dr. Kim explained what she was seeing. She directed the people to shout "fire" and lay hands on each other to stir it up. A woman who had been experiencing severe back pain from a long-term disability felt fire come upon her. The Lord healed her!

During a ministry time with a large group of very dedicated leaders from an entire region, the Lord gave Dr. Kim several passages of scripture, short messages and words for the times and seasons as well as for the region. The Leaders received encouragement from the Lord saying they could now make sense of what they were seeing happen and experiencing. God's grace and care for his leaders is astounding.

Here is one of Dr. Kim's favorite moments. At one church she was led to activate intergenerational ministry. Children were escorted to the platform to dance. A 2 1/2 year old boy got up on the platform and stood in front of the drums. He began to beat the air as he danced to the beating of the drummer and the Holy Spirit was manifestly present as he offered his childlike worship taking joy in music. Children of all ages began celebrating with dance before the Lord. A group of about 12 teens came to stand in the front of the platform. The adults were directed to come forward and surround the young people to pray and prophesy into their lives. It was later learned the group of teens prayed and prophesied over had come off the street. A woman had gone out to gather them and bring them in to hear the word of The Lord! They were not part of the church, nor were they saved! Many of them returned the next day. There were salvations and encounters with the Holy Spirit.

One of the most poignant moments happened in a time of blessing, releasing and commissioning for women. The Senior Leader of the church came forward to repent to the women on behalf of any leader

who had held them back and for any abuse they may have suffered at the hands of a man. Women were weeping and getting free. They shouted the phrase, "My Name is _____. My Heavenly Father has a vision. I am his daughter!" The women then surrounded the men to bless and break off the oppression and stress from the pressure to perform. The men also shouted they had a name known by their father who has a vision for their lives.

On the final day of one particular conference, the Lord showed up in manifest presence releasing an anointing for intercession for the city. A woman came forward with a word about fire and angels in the room. The Pastor ministered a short while and called Dr. Kim to the platform. The Holy Spirit directed the church to begin to intercede for the city. The manifest presence increased till most were on the floor. Dr. Kim led intercession for the city of Ardmore for about 30 minutes, weeping and explaining what she was "hearing and seeing." After a time of prophetic intercession, the young worship leader, only 19 years old, tapped into the Spirit for prophetic worship for 30 minutes. The presence of God became thick as the whole church was called to "let go and take the hand of Jesus" for the new season. Nearly every person in the room lay out on the floor with much weeping. Inner healing came spontaneously for many.
